



When Will I Get My Refund?

Quick Facts for the IRS:

- The IRS usually processes returns within 14-21 days of e-filing a return
- If you have a Child Tax Credit, Earned Income Credit, or American Opportunity Credit your refund may take longer to process
- You can look up where your current year tax refund is at in the process by going to <https://www.irs.gov/refunds>



Quick Facts for Idaho:

- Idaho usually takes between 4-8 weeks to process an income tax refund after e-filing a return
- You can look up where your current year Idaho tax refund is at in the process by going to <https://tax.idaho.gov/> and clicking on "REFUND STATUS" or by calling (208) 364-7389

What If I Owe?

Quick Facts:

- Federal and Idaho tax liabilities for personal income taxes are due by **April 15th**.
- Penalties and interest begin accruing April 15th, the filing deadline, and continue until the balance is paid in full
- A tax return extension does not extend the deadline for payment
- If you have a payment plan in place and need to include a current tax liability you must call the IRS to get your plans combined



Ways to pay the IRS:

- Mail a check with the voucher we provide with your tax return
- Electronic funds withdrawal through our tax filing software
- Pay electronically through <https://www.irs.gov/payments> and choosing a payment option
- Apply for a payment plan through <https://www.irs.gov/payments/online-payment-agreement-application>

Ways to pay Idaho:

- Mail a check with the voucher that we provide with your tax return
- In person at the local Idaho State Tax Commission office: 1910 NW Blvd Ste 100 Cd'A, ID 83814
- Pay electronically through <https://tax.idaho.gov/> and clicking on "FAST & EASY: QUICKPAY"
